Social Media Turning Teens into Depressed Recluses

Social media is turning teens into recluses, who prefer cyber relationships to real-life interactions. They are far more open about sexuality, and can freely express who they are and what sexual preferences they have.

Dr Lori Eddy, a Johannesburg counselling psychologist, notes that there are pros and cons to social media use. Eddy feels that the problem of online bullying is one of the causes of this, and she has a number of teenage patients "who have convinced their parents to let them have plastic surgery due to extreme bullying based on their appearance".

Eddy urges teens to regulate and balance his or her own screen time with non-screen activities.

Let's Talk About Sex, Babies

Telling preteens about sex, asking them why pornography is so common and teaching them that they have both the right and the responsibility to be in control of what they will and will not do sexually.

Those issues were on the table when the UN Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (Unesco) and several African countries, including South Africa, The guidance report includes definitions of various sex-related terms, ranging from "heteronormativity" – the belief that heterosexuality is the normal or default sexual orientation – to "transphobia", or "the fear, discomfort, intolerance or hatred of transgender people".
